THIS IS A WINNING CHIP TIMED EVENT!

Chip timing will help to ensure quicker, more accurate results.

All USCF licensed racers competing in the full stage race **will need** a chip. USCF licensed racers finishing the 80 mile Bald Mountain Road Race stage in Evanston will receive an electronic time. Electronic times will also be recorded for the Time Trial and Criterium stages.

USCF licensed racers competing only in the 47 mile Bald Mountain Road Race stage finishing at Christmas Meadows in the national forest **will not** need a chip. You will receive a finish time as recorded by a USCF official.

USCF licensed racers competing only in the 80 mile Bald Mountain Road Race stage finishing in Evanston **will need** a chip.

Recreational citizen racers competing in the 47 mile Bald Mountain Road Race stage finishing at Christmas Meadows in the national forest **will not** need a chip. You will receive a finish time as recorded by a USCF official.

Competitive citizen racers competing in the 80 mile Bald Mountain Road Race stage finishing in Evanston **will not need** a chip. You will receive a finish time as recorded by a USCF official. If you desire an electronic time, you will need to rent a chip.

Utah Cycling Association (UCA) members have the opportunity to acquire a chip from the UCA.

For those who do not have a chip, you will need to rent a chip on-site at the road race start in Kamas. The cost to rent a chip for the event is \$10* payable *only* with a credit card. This cost is in addition to entry fees.

***If you do not return the chip after racing, your credit card will be charged \$44.95 for the cost of the chip.**

In 2009, the High Uintas Classic will celebrate its **21st year**. The High Uintas Classic is nationally recognized for its excellence. Race **“OVER THE TOP”** at Bald Mountain Pass, elevation **10,700 feet**. Varied terrain, high elevation, alpine lakes, and breathtaking scenery make this event one of the most physically demanding and picturesque in the West. The cash purse is \$8,000. **WEATHER WATCH:** Be prepared for rapidly changing weather conditions. Cold weather can lead to hypothermia. Bring appropriate clothing.

KAMAS TO EVANSTON BALD MOUNTAIN ROAD RACE

Presented by Cook-Sanders Associates, Inc., The Spence Law Firm, and Kamas City, UT. Saturday, June 20th. Start time 9 a.m. at Kamas City Hall, located at 170 North Main. Race follows the Mirror Lake Scenic Byway through the Uinta Mountains to Evanston for USCF Pro Men, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, Mas 35-44(A/B), Mas 45-54, USCF Pro Women, 1, 2, 3, and Competitive Citizens/Tandem - **80 miles**. Race follows the Mirror Lake Scenic Byway through the Uinta Mountains to the Christmas Meadows turn-off for USCF Junior Men, Mas 55+, USCF Women 4 and Mas 35+, Jr. Women, and Recreational Citizens - **47 miles**. Beginning elevation in Kamas 6,400 feet. Elevation at Bald Mountain Pass in the Uinta Mountains 10,700 feet. Elevation at North Slope Road 8,300 feet. Ending elevation in Evanston 6,750 feet. TIME BONUS for King of the Mountain and Queen of the Mountain; and TIME BONUS at finish line, as listed in race bible. **SNOW REPORT: IF Bald Mountain Pass is closed on June 20th because of snow, the Road Race will start in Evanston at 9 a.m. IF this happens, USCF Pro Men, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, Mas 35-44 (A/B) and 45-54, Pro Wom, 1, 2, 3 and Comp Cits race to snowline and back to Evanston. All others race to snowline and back to Christmas Meadows. Please visit www.evanstoncycling.org for snow report updates.**
